

American Society of Health-System Pharmacists Clinical Skills Competition

POLICY: The Local American Society of Health-System Pharmacists (ASHP) Clinical Skills Competition shall be held prior to the early meeting registration for the ASHP Midyear Clinical Meeting. All South Dakota State University College of Pharmacy and Allied Health Professions students are invited to participate. The winning team must agree to the following procedure prior to any award disbursement.

PROCEDURE:

1. The winning team will participate in the national ASHP Clinical Skills Competition held at the ASHP Midyear Clinical Meeting every December. Information about the competition is available on the ASHP website at www.ashp.org.
2. The winning team will be encouraged to give an informal discussion about the local and national clinical skills competition at an American Pharmacists Association Academy of Student Pharmacists (APhA-ASP) Meeting in the spring following the national competition. This meeting will be organized by APhA-ASP and the ASHP Clinical Skills Coordinator and an example outline of the discussion will be provided.
3. The winning team will be invited to attend the South Dakota Society of Health-System Pharmacists (SDSHP) Annual Meeting to be recognized at the awards ceremony. The winning team will receive free registration to the SDSHP Annual Meeting.
4. If the winning team agrees to all of the above they will receive a monetary award from SDSHP which includes travel money to the ASHP Midyear Clinical Meeting totaling no more than \$1000 or \$500 per student. The winning team will pre-pay for their travel expenses and they will be reimbursed after the Midyear meeting. Receipts for expenses must be submitted to the SDSHP Treasurer.
